It's logical that when you make replicas of cars that could hold their own in a museum case, creating the truck that would have hauled them around has the potential to be spectacular. Mark McCourt was doing photography for "The Goods" in the February 2012 issue of *Hemmings Sports & Exotic Car*, and agreed to hold out some images so we could share them with you.



It's the 1957 Fiat 642 Scuderia Ferrari Racing Transporter, modeled in 1/18th scale by [CMC Models](#). More than 3,000 pieces go into this. It's 19 inches long, seven inches high and weighs around nine pounds. CMC has a raft of excellent Ferrari models that would complement it perfectly.



You'll have to read the *HS&EC* review for the whole story, but consider this: See those cables and turnbuckles holding up the ramps? They're functional. Call 585-292-7280 and be prepared to lay out about 900 bucks, including taxes and shipping. My only wish is that somewhere, somebody, sometime, does a classic American fire truck such as a Mack LJ or 70th Anniversary Seagrave that's this good.
